An Introduction





StyleCraft Corporation can trace its origins back to StyleCraft Kitchens, a company founded in 1962 by three partners. Two of the partners had design and retail experience in the cabinet business dating back to the original Quaker Maid Kitchens. The third partner was a cabinet maker named Norman Hahn. The company's first home was an 8,500 square foot plant in East Earl Township, PA. Several years later the plant was expanded to 17,000 square feet and about that time Norman Hahn left the partnership and founded Conestoga Wood Specialties. The two other original partners continued to operate StyleCraft Kitchens. One ran the plant operations and the other maintained a retail store in Shillington, PA. The bulk of the sales were through the retail operation, but a few other dealers were slowly added.

By the time StyleCraft Corporation purchased the assets of StyleCraft Kitchens in 1986, the retail operation no longer existed and the bulk of the sales were through two dealers in Washington, DC, one in Allentown, PA and one in Wyckoff, NJ.

After many years of operating the original plant in East Earl, a 30,000 square foot plant in nearby Terre Hill, PA was purchased and extensively renovated. This is the current manufacturing site for the company.

As this booklet is written there are 22 employees, some of whom are still here from the StyleCraft Kitchens era. Others have been added, trained as skilled cabinetmakers and finishers, and they continue the traditions of fine cabinetmaking that have always been the hallmark of this company.

Many things have changed over the years as modern equipment and methods have changed in the shop and ever more efficient computers and communications have revolutionized the way quoting and ordering are handled. What has not changed is the company's commitment to manufacturing the best possible cabinets and accessories and providing the most extraordinary customer service.

In the pages that follow our goal is to present a primer for a potential new dealer to get an overview of our products, services, pricing and warranties.

How we go to market

StyleCraft is sold by a network of dealers, primarily located on the East Coast. Our dealers do not fit any one profile, as they can be anyone from an independent architect or designer to a full retail showroom employing a number of designers and sales people. Creative people of all types are welcome. Depending upon your geographical location you will be dealing with an independent manufacturer's representative or StyleCraft directly.

Orders are written with software from Advanceware that both writes the order and prices as the order is written. StyleCraft will guide a new user of the software through the start-up process. A PDF manual is available that covers the basics of how to use the software. We are always available to help if you are having difficulty entering an order.

Special items often require special quoting. Please send us all of the pertinent information, and particularly any drawings of the item and we will provide a written quote. This process usually takes less than 40 hours, but can take longer when parts or materials must be specially ordered. We are also available to help with the pricing of orders until a new dealer is comfortable with the pricing software.

Miscellaneous orders are communicated by fax or e-mail. An acknowledgement that includes pricing is returned with 48 hours, unless special items have to be ordered.

Our terms are 50% at the time the order is confirmed and the balance at the time of shipment. We do not accept credit cards but have software that allows us to accept a copy of a check that is either faxed or e-mailed. We require that the check be received the evening before a delivery. After a relationship with a dealer has been established, we ship orders for follow-up parts or orders for less than \$1,000 on account, 2% 10, net 30. When the delivery of orders is delayed by the dealer/purchaser, payment is expected on the original delivery date. There is some storage space for finished products and it will be made available on a first come basis. If orders are delayed and there is no space for them they will be sent to a storage facility and fees will apply.

Delivery is scheduled only after an order has been confirmed and is typically about six to seven weeks. During very busy seasons lead times may be longer. Delivery of follow-up items is scheduled as soon as possible based on the item. There are always emergencies and problems and we do everything we possibly can to accommodate these unusual circumstances. Please note that the dealer is finally and exclusively responsible for the accuracy of an entered, reviewed and confirmed order.

Deliveries are on a StyleCraft truck or a specialized cabinet carrier. You will be contacted approximately two weeks prior to the completion of an order to arrange a specific delivery date. Cabinets and parts are always blanket wrapped and shipped like fine furniture. Shipments are typically made with one driver who will move the products to the tailgate for off-loading by the recipient. Other arrangements can be made when requested. When possible, miscellaneous orders will be packaged and shipped UPS.

StyleCraft Cabinets – How are they made?

StyleCraft manufacturers both face frame and full-access cabinets. Both are manufactured from the plywood veneers and hardwoods of your choice. The plywood veneers are all manufactured with formaldehyde-free adhesives. Full-access cabinets can also be manufactured from melamine coated fiber board that is either white or printed to simulate

wood. Face frame cabinets typically have $\frac{3}{4}$ " or 1" face frames and doors. Full-access cabinets can have either $\frac{3}{4}$ " or 1" doors.

The different cabinet constructions are described by our "Series." A summary of the series and their pricing differences are presented in the Appendix. The basic features of the cabinet construction are as follows.

Face Frame Cabinets

Face frame cabinets are constructed of veneer core and solid woods. The veneers are all plain sliced or better. All of the veneer core is manufactured with formaldehyde-free adhesives.

There are a number of face frame designs that range from a square frame inset to a $\frac{1}{4}$ " beaded frame, to a $\frac{3}{8}$ " beaded frame to a heavily detailed $\frac{5}{8}$ " bead on a 1" thick frame with a $\frac{3}{4}$ " door and drawer. All of the framed series can be executed in $\frac{3}{4}$ " or 1". When 1" doors and drawers are ordered, the face frame is the same thickness. The overall cabinet size is adjusted to accommodate the 1" framing and base cabinets remain 24" deep.

Wall Cabinets have $\frac{3}{4}$ " ends, $\frac{1}{2}$ " bottoms, tops and backs. The cabinet is constructed with tongue and groove joints and the face frame is mortised and tenoned. Shelves are $\frac{3}{4}$ " thick with a $\frac{3}{16}$ " solid wood bull nosed front edge. Wall cabinets have a standard depth of 13" but can be increased to 15" at standard pricing. The top rail is 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide to facilitate the attachment of decorative moldings.

Base Cabinets have $\frac{3}{4}$ " ends, $\frac{1}{2}$ " bottoms, tops and backs. A full dust cover is standard except for sink bases. Cabinet and shelf construction is the same as the wall cabinet. Standard depth is 24" and standard height is 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Toe kicks are 4" high and 3" deep.

Drawers are constructed of $\frac{5}{8}$ " soft maple with a rounded top edge, $\frac{1}{2}$ " veneer core bottoms, and are mounted on Blum soft-close slides. Drawer fronts are attached to the box with eccentric screws to ease alignment.

Tall cabinets have $\frac{3}{4}$ " ends, $\frac{1}{2}$ " bottoms, tops and backs. Standard depths are 18" and 24", with standard heights of 84", 90" and 96".

Cabinets may be specified with either fully concealed soft-close hinges or traditional barrel hinges. If the barrel hinge is used, a soft-close mechanism that uses rare earth magnets is standard.

Full-Access Cabinets

Full-access cabinets are constructed of veneer core as well as white and printed melamine.

Wall cabinets have $\frac{3}{4}$ " ends as well as $\frac{3}{4}$ " tops, bottoms and backs. The bottom of the cabinet is constructed of the interior species and is sanded, flush, and finished. Standard depth is 13", but up to 15" may be specified at no further cost. The overlay door adds the thickness of the door plus $\frac{1}{8}$ " clearance between the door and the cabinet. Fully concealed 125 degree soft close hinges are standard.

Base cabinets have $\frac{3}{4}$ " ends as well as $\frac{3}{4}$ " tops, bottoms, and backs. The top is constructed of two 4" wide stringers, but a full dust cover can be specified. Standard depth is 24" plus the thickness of the door and $\frac{1}{8}$ " clearance between the door and the cabinet. Toe kicks are the same as framed cabinets – 4" high and 3" deep.

Tall cabinets have $\frac{3}{4}$ " ends, tops, bottoms and backs. Standard depths are 18" and 24", plus the door and clearance.

Drawer construction is the same as framed cabinets.

Custom Features

Virtually all types of modifications and additions to the cabinets are offered in the catalog. Those that are not are still very likely available but require a quote from sales service.

Finishing

StyleCraft currently finishes all of its products with Polyurethane, referred to as "Polytuff" color for paint.

Polyurethane is used for the paint finishes because of its superior toughness and the fact that it is far less likely to show hairline cracking at the joints. StyleCraft makes this finish available in a wide range of colors, but we can match almost any color when requested. The easiest way to order special paint colors is to order from a Benjamin Moore or Sherwin Williams color wheel.

Stain colors and paint and glaze combinations can be matched as well, but require a bit more work. In all cases, a sample will be submitted for a customer signature before the order can proceed.

Special finishes of all types including distressing, wire brushing, and furniture toning are available.

The interior of painted cabinets will be finished the same color as the exterior. Paint and glaze cabinets will have an interior the color of the paint underlying the glazed finish. Stained cabinets will have natural interiors. The interior of an open cabinet or one with glass doors will be finished like the exterior. In paint, or paint and glaze cabinets, interior parts like drawer bodies and shelves can be finished the same as the cabinet interior or left natural at no additional expense.

Cabinets can be left unfinished, primed, primed exterior with finished interior, or any combination of these.

Our standard finish sheen is 40 degree. Low sheen finishes that typically are between 10 and 15 degrees are available at no additional cost. Sheens higher than 40 degree incur additional expense.

A complete guide to finishes and pricing is included in the appendix.

The appendix also includes a guide to wood species and species pricing, a copy of our Limited Warranty, and our Series pricing guide. Also included are a floor plan and elevations of a small kitchen and the accompanying pricing as an example of the format and costs you can expect from StyleCraft.

Environmental Commitment



StyleCraft will continue to exceed industry guidelines for air quality, resource management in our products and processes, as well as our responsibility to our employees and our community.

Our commitment to our employees includes providing a safe and healthy workplace as evidenced by our exemplary safety record, as well as documented compliance with OSHA and other regulatory agencies.

“Green” responsibility in the woodworking industry is often focused on the question of the formaldehyde content of its products. All wood products naturally emit small amounts of formaldehyde and this cannot be eliminated. The raw materials, glues, resins or finishes used by StyleCraft will not result in any measurable emission of formaldehyde beyond the natural content of the wood.

Wood Guide

Only the highest quality materials are used in StyleCraft cabinetry. Our cabinets are constructed of both plywood that has a veneer of the species and solid wood that is used for framing, door construction, and other applications. The veneers we use are all plain sliced or better, which means that the grain of the veneer is straighter and more consistent than, for example, rotary-cut veneer which is less expensive and less attractive. The solid woods for the doors and frames are selected for their consistency in color and grain. Even a natural finish will have limited but very pleasing variation to the color and grain of the wood. The types of wood we consider as standard species are:

Cherry—A premium hardwood often associated with fine furniture. Cherry wood is characterized by a distinctive and subtle grain pattern, the presence of sap marks or slight dark inclusions in the surface, and a reddish color. Cherry is also known for the way it changes color as it is exposed to light. It deepens and mellows as it ages, and when pieces have been selected properly, it will age evenly and beautifully. Never accept Cherry with light color pieces in the panel. This is sapwood, which is not acceptable in first quality cabinets.

Rustic Cherry—Use this species for antiqued or very informal designs. The specification allows knots, split knots and other defects. The knots will be of varying size and are both sound and unsound. Panels will not be matched for color and there may be some sap wood.

Maple—A hard durable wood that tends to have very little grain definition. It is a popular wood for cabinet construction and again, when properly selected, will result in an even, pleasant appearance. In our opinion, Maple is much more desirable in light colors than dark. Sometimes the grain of this wood can absorb a dark stain in a very uneven pattern, which can detract from the natural beauty of the wood.

Red Oak—A versatile hardwood that has a pronounced open grain and a reddish color. Red Oak is popular for cabinet construction because it wears well and is reasonably priced. In lighter colors, the amount of the grain influences the overall color because the open grain typically absorbs more of the stain than the other surfaces. In darker colors, the influence of the grain is diminished.

White Oak—This very heavy hardwood is not white at all but rather a very attractive gray/brown that, when properly finished, can be used very effectively and can produce a stunning look. It is often specified in its natural color with perhaps some accent staining or antiquing called “glazing”.

Knotty Pine—This softwood is most recognizable to everyone. Its rustic appearance results in a casual look that many people like and prefer. A word of caution—this wood does not wear as well as the hardwoods, and dents and dings cannot be avoided. Even with these shortcomings, however, beautiful cabinet and furniture pieces can be yours.

Clear Pine—Same as Knotty Pine, without the knots. It is more expensive because it must be selected, but it too can be used to craft beautiful cabinets.

White Birch—When people specify Birch, they are most commonly referring to White Birch. This wood is hard and serviceable with very little grain definition. Like Maple, it is best finished in lighter colors and, in fact, it is sometimes difficult to distinguish from Maple.

Red Birch—Red Birch does not come from a Red Birch tree, but rather from the heart of the White Birch tree. This wood is selected for its reddish color and very beautiful and distinctive grain. Some people even think it approaches the look of Cherry. Almost always left its natural color, Red Birch is used for a casual look, where the natural beauty of the wood is to be emphasized.

Alder—Alder is the softest of the hardwoods. It has a straight grain and brown color and can sometimes be mistaken for Cherry.

Paint Grade—This is Hard Maple that is used for painted or painted and glazed finishes. The wood is hard, durable, and well-suited for painted finishes.

Walnut—Usually American Walnut is prized for its rich brown color, beautiful grain, and durability for furniture or cabinet making.

Mahogany—Mahogany ranks among the finest cabinet woods. It is exceptionally stable with a rich, light brown color and has a natural luster. The open grain can require filling to achieve a smooth surface.

Special Requests—StyleCraft will work with you to accommodate any special request for cabinets manufactured from an exotic species not normally produced by us. Contact our office to discuss your special needs.

Finish Special Effects

When ordering these special effects, order a sample of the finish for your client. There are simply too many ways to interpret and execute these finishes.

- **Aged Furniture**—This finish employs the techniques used by furniture manufacturers to replicate fine antiques. Depending upon a client's wishes, glazing, distressing, brush glazing, spattering, or fly specking and highlighting may be used. This process always begins with a stain. The four color samples for this process should be used as guide.
- **Distressed**—A process of mechanically damaging the wood surface with dents and small cuts. Some joints are gouged to make them appear cracked and edges are cut to simulate aging.
- **Worn**—When referring to a painted surface, it means that the paint has been rubbed through to stained wood underneath. When referring to the wood itself, it means that the wood will actually be worn away, leaving a rounded or broken corner or edge. Worn doors, when inset, will no longer have even gaps between the doors and the frame.
- **Worming**—This finish is most commonly on Knotty Cherry, White Oak, Quartersawn White Oak, and Pine. Simulated worm holes and lines are cut into the finished surfaces, and these cabinets are mildly distressed. The markings are accented by using a dark glaze. The last coat of finish is low sheen top coat.
- **Antiquing**—Choose the level of antiquing your client wishes to have from the following guidelines. Once again, we point out that there is so much variability in the use of these techniques that it is essential to have a sample made specifically for the job.
 - **Delicate**—This finish will have very mild and random distressing accented by glazing. An edge may be a bit worn, painted finishes may have a scratch, but the overall look will be rather clean. The look should suggest neglect rather than hard wear.
 - **Defined**— The piece must be glazed and the distressing will be noticeable. Cracked joints begin to appear, obvious rounding of some corners, a bit of wearing-through of the paint, and on the stained pieces, a little fly specking. The corners and ridges of door moldings will have a significant build-up of the glaze.
 - **Dramatic**—The distressing is going to be very heavy. The piece will be marked all over. Worm holes will be prevalent, joints will be gouged, edges will be rounded, and paint will be worn through in a number of places, including around the pulls or handles. This piece will look as if it was used hard, if not somewhat abused.
 - **Primitive**—This finish will make the piece look as if it was left in the barn for a couple of decades and only recently brought out. Heavily distressed and gouged with cracked joints and edges that are worn away as if actually cut by a tool or even a friendly rodent. Heavily glazed over a worn-through paint color, the finish is blotchy, even dirty looking. Worm holes are deep, as are the scratch lines across the surface. The piece will look abused and forgotten.

STYLECRAFT CORPORATION and its agents shall be the sole judge of these standards.

The color standards that STYLECRAFT provides, whether standard or custom, are guidelines for the final color. The wood substrates and the very nature of the artistic processes being used result in subtle variations in their finish. STYLECRAFT and its agents shall be the sole judge of an acceptable color match.

Having determined that a warranty condition exists, STYLECRAFT CORPORATION alone will decide to repair or replace the defective item. The cost of removal of the defective materials, transportation and the installation of replacements is not covered.

This warranty applies only to the original consumer purchaser of StyleCraft cabinets. It creates no rights in connection with products purchased for use in construction of new homes or products purchased for commercial use. It creates no rights for installation contractors, purchasers for resale, dealers or any subsequent users.

Once the repair or replacement has occurred, a claim for repair or replacement under this warranty extinguishes all future claims under this warranty. This warranty excludes claims for consequential and incidental damages.

This warranty also limits actions or claims for breach of express warranty, implied warranty, implied warranty of fitness for a particular purpose and implied warranty of merchantability to two years from the date the cabinets are shipped from our factory.

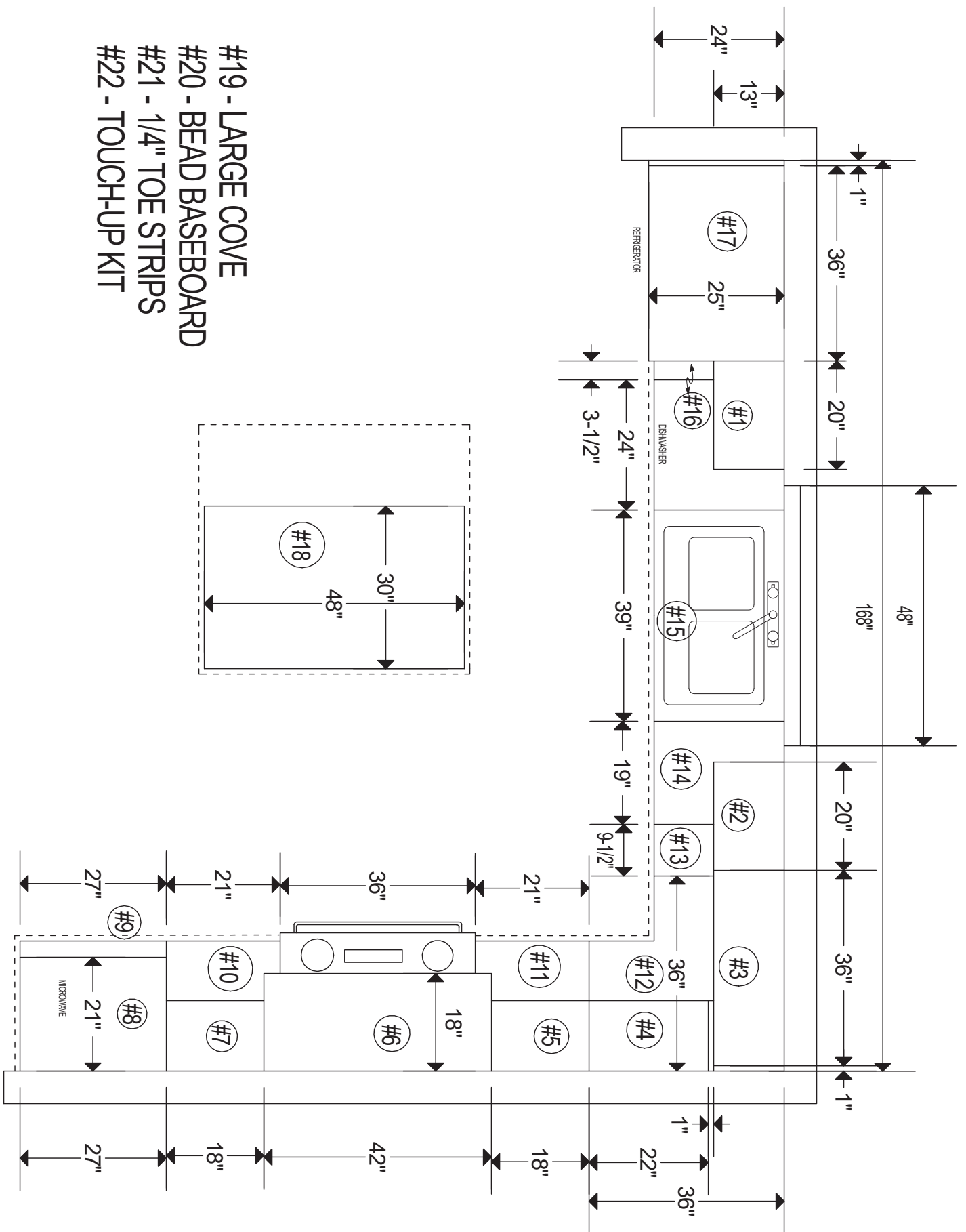

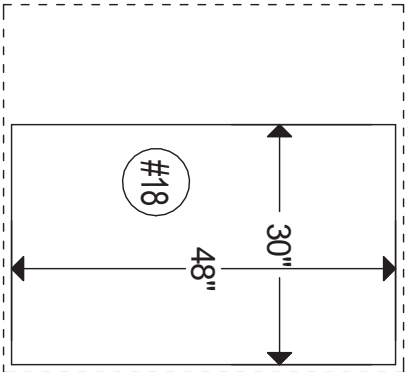
