Use and Care

Dust is highly abrasive and can dull the finish if wiped off with a dry cloth. To avoid this, use a feather, lamb's wool, microfiber or static duster.

All regular cleaning should be completed with a soft slightly damp 100% lint free or micro-fiber or cotton cloth. Warm clean tap water only or use with a mild detergent is all that is required for general cleaning.

Avoid excess rubbing and always wipe with the grain direction of the wood surface. Do not allow any standing or pooling water on cabinet surfaces, frame or door joints.

It is important to remove any oil, grease, and food residue as soon as possible. Excessive exposure or buildup of items such as, but not limited to, vinegar, citrus juice, ketchup, coffee, olive oil, red wine, mustard, or mayonnaise may stain or damage the finish.

The use of spray, liquid or paste cleaners or waxes are not necessary or recommended with your finished cabinetry.
